Glatfelter Donates Bestsellers to Local Libraries

York, Pa. (July 24, 2002) – In continuing support of York County libraries, Glatfelter has donated three hardcover books recently listed on the *New York Times* Bestsellers List to the 14 libraries of the York County Library System. Master of the Senate: The Years of Lyndon Johnson by Robert A. Caro, is printed on paper produced by Glatfelter's Spring Grove Facility. Self Matters: Creating Your Life from the Inside Out by Phillip C. McGraw, Ph.D. and Daddy's Little Girl by Mary Higgins Clark are both printed on paper produced at the Company's Neenah, Wisconsin Facility.

Glatfelter began donating bestsellers to York County's libraries in June 2000 as a demonstration of its social responsibility and support of the York community. Since the Company started this program, 26 titles printed on Glatfelter paper have reached the *New York Times* Bestsellers list, including Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone by J. K. Rowling and John Adams by David McCullough, and all have been donated to York County's libraries. The Company offers the same program to the library located near its paper facility in Neenah.

In September 2000, Glatfelter was named "Corporate Citizen of the Year" by the Pennsylvania Citizens for Better Libraries for its continuing commitment to the libraries in York County.
