Glatfelter Featured on The History Channel

York, Pa. (August 5, 2002) – Glatfelter is pleased to announce that the Spring Grove Facility will be featured in The History Channel’s “Hands On History: Paper” program on Saturday, August 10, 2002 at 7 p.m. EST.
