Glatfelter Donates New Tom Clancy Best-Seller to York County Libraries

York, Pa. (October 4, 2002) – In continuing support of York County libraries, Glatfelter has donated the recent Tom Clancy novel, Red Rabbit to each of the 14 libraries of the York County Library System. The book is currently listed on the *New York Times* Best-Seller List and is printed on paper manufactured at Glatfelter’s Spring Grove Facility in Spring Grove, Pennsylvania.

Glatfelter began donating bestsellers to York County’s libraries in June 2000 as a demonstration of its social responsibility and support of the York community. The York County Library System consists of the County’s 14 public libraries. Its mission is to serve the York County community and enrich individual lives by supplying information, providing recreation, promoting literacy, and encouraging life-long learning.

Since the Company started this program, 27 titles printed on Glatfelter paper have reached the *New York Times* Best-Sellers list, including John Adams by David McCullough and Daddy’s Little Girl by Mary Higgins Clark, and all have been donated to York County’s libraries. The Company offers the same program to the library located near its paper facility in Neenah.

In September 2000, Glatfelter was named “Corporate Citizen of the Year” by the Pennsylvania Citizens for Better Libraries for its continuing commitment to York County libraries.
